Galatians

1. The beginning of the gospel in Galatia. Paul and Barnabas were sent to Antioch by the church at Jerusalem. They went to Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe, and then returned to Antioch. The church at Antioch was strengthened, and Paul and Barnabas were sent to Cyprus and Asia Minor.

2. Paul's epistle to the Galatians. He writes to the churches in Galatia, which were being troubled by false teachers who were teaching that the law was necessary for salvation. Paul emphasizes that salvation is by faith in Christ alone, and that the law is a curse. He also discusses the role of the Holy Spirit and the importance of love.

3. Paul's journey to Jerusalem. He goes to Jerusalem to meet with the apostles and discuss the issue of the law. He is accompanied by Barnabas and Titus. He meets with James, Peter, and Paul, and they discuss the matter. Paul's speech is recorded in Acts 15.

4. Paul's journey to Rome. He is arrested in Jerusalem and taken to Rome. He is held in custody for two years. He then writes his epistle to the Romans. He is eventually released and returns to his home in Tarsus.
